Report on the meeting and Interaction with Pensioners' Associations at Bengaluru by Secretary, Department of Pension and Pensioners Welfare (DOPPW) on 04-11-2023

Department of Pension and Pensioners Welfare, New Delhi had called for a meeting of Pensioners on Saturday the 4th of November, 2023 at the Auditorium of the State Bank of India, Avenue Road, Bengaluru 560009. Sri V Srinivas, IAS, Secretary, DOP&PW presided over the meeting in which Sri S N Mathur, Additional Secretary, Sri Ruchir Mittal, Director (Pension) and Smt. Ramanjit Kaur, Consultant were also present. Sri Krishna Sharma, Chief General Manager, State Bank of India was present. Pension Department had arranged for an interactive session between Pensioners Associations and the Secretary DOPPW in which the Representatives of Pensioners Associations and Pensioners were invited to participate.

Three Pensioners Associations identified under the National E -Governance Plan (NeGP) Viz. Karnataka P&T Pensioners' Association, Karnataka Central Government Pensioners' Association and All India BSNL Pensioners Welfare Association were invited to the meeting. Karnataka P&T Pensioners' Association, an affiliate of CCCGPA, Karnataka had requested the CCCGPA affiliated Pensioners Associations to send some of their members to the meeting on 4-11-2023.

From KP&TPA, Sri G Babu, President, Smt. N Nagalakshmi, Vice President, Sri K B Krishna Rao , Secretary, E C Members S/s V S Naik, K Nagesh, Viswanatha Rao, C Ramakrishna Reddy, M B Hegde and Members S/s A Poobalan, K N Ramachandra Bhat, S N Hiremani, R Krishna Murthy, R N Rajan, K Anand and a few others attended.

Sri S Radhakrishna , General Secretary, CCCGPA Karnataka and Secretary, IA&AD Pensioners' Association, Representatives of KITDPA, KCGPA, AIBSNLPWA, CE&CPA were present. The auditorium was filled to its capacity.

Smt. Ramanjit Kaur, Consultant DOP&PW, extended a warm welcome to all. Commencement of her speech in Kannada, the language of the State of Karnataka, was applauded by the audience.

Sri S N Mathur, Additional Secretary, DOP&PW formally welcomed all and mentioned about the Nation-wide Digital Life Certificate Campaign being conducted by the Pension Department .

Sri Ruchir Mittal, Director DoP&PW, through a power point presentation, explained the process of generating digital life certificate. He said that DOP&PW, in collaboration with UIDAI & MeitY, has launched Face Authentication Technology for submission of Digital Life Certificate by about 70 lakhs Central Govt. Pensioners. Digital Life Certificate through Face Authentication Technology is based on Aadhaar using Android based Smartphone. This breakthrough technology, launched in November 2021, has reduced the dependence of pensioners on external bio-metric devices and has made the process more accessible and affordable ,

Shri V. Srinivas, Secretary (P&PW) in his address spoke about the initiatives taken by Pension Department towards enhancing 'Ease of Living' of pensioners. He said that the present Campaign is one such initiative to ensure that the technique of using Face Authentication for DLC submission reaches pensioners in the remotest areas, to enable them to understand and use the technique from the comfort of their homes. He exhorted bankers and Pensioners Associations to make this Nationwide Digital Life Certificate Campaign into a people's movement.

Shri Krishna Sharma, CGM, State Bank of India, Bengaluru Circle addressed the participants and informed that the Bank would

provide all support to ensure success of the Campaign which would benefit the pensioners in Bengaluru . He further said that a help desk would be setup in every SBI branch.

Executives of the Pensioners' Associations were invited to speak. Sri Girish Kanagotagi, President KCGPA in his brief speech mentioned about the technical problems faced by pensioners migrated to Sparsh. Sri P Gangadhara Rao, Vice President, AIBSNLPWA in his speech mentioned about non-revision of pension of BSNL pensioners as per 7th CPC on a par with other central pensioners and referred to the order passed by the CAT Principal Bench on 20-9-2023 allowing the application filed by AIBSNLPWA.

Sri K B Krishna Rao, Secretary, KP&TPA thanked the Secretary and all the Officers of DOPPW for including the association in "SCOVA" reconstituted on 26-9-2023 for the term 2023-25. About Digital Life Certificate campaign , he said that KP&TPA in association with Coffee Board Pensioners Association topped the list in number of DLC camps organised, DLCs generated in camps and

during house visits in 2022 and it is all set to further improve upon its previous year's performance in the year 2023 as the associations have planned about 30 DLC camps not only in Bengaluru but also in other cities of Karnataka like Mysuru, Hassan, Chikkamagaluru and Shivamogga. About KP&TPA, Krishna Rao said that its membership stands at 3500 which includes pensioners of all Central Govt Departments. He said that 2 of its members Smt. N Nagalakshmi, Retd. Chief Accounts Officer, O/o the G M Postal Accounts & Finance and Sri P Damodara Bhat, Retd. Senior Superintendent RMS, have been bestowed with "Anubhav Awards" by the Department of Pension. He thanked the CPPC, SBI for promptly taking up the grievances of pensioners brought to its notice by the Association.

Smt. N Nagalakshmi, Vice President KP&TPA an "ANUBHAV AWARDEE" was specially invited to address the gathering.

SBI had organised a DLC Camp after the meeting in which a good no. of pensioners participated and submitted their life certificates.

LIFE CERTIFICATE

Assisting Pensioners in submission of their Annual Life Certificate-2023

Yet another Stellar joint Performance by Karnataka P&T Pensioners' Association and Coffee Board Pensioners' Association, Bengaluru

Improving upon their last year's joint performance in helping pensioners to register their annual life certificates with the Pension Disbursing Authorities – Banks and Post Offices- for continued payment of their pension, the 2 Pensioners' Associations named above, both affiliates of CCCGPA, Karnataka, in the month of November 2023, organised 32 Digital Life Certificate Camps - 27 in Bengaluru City in various localities and one each in Mysuru, Thumakuru, Hassan, Shivamogga and Chikkamagaluru managed by 23 volunteers who extended their selfless yeomen services to the pensioner community. The number of volunteers increased from 13 in the year 2022 to 23 in 2023. They were well supported by the Office bearers and members of Residents Welfare Associations, Senior Citizens Forums, Old age homes and of course their friends and acquaintances. The hosts provided the required infrastructure needed for a successful conduct of the camps. The Hospitality extended to the volunteers is noteworthy. It is heartening to record that the Officers of the Department of Posts -the Superintendents and the Head Postmasters extended their helping hand to the associations in holding the DLC camps in the premises of the Head Post Offices.

The volunteers visited residences of 949 aged pensioners, some of whom were bedridden, some using a wheelchair for their mobility, and a few living with oxygen support. They visited some Hospitals and Old age homes also. Their visits to Old age homes to generate life certificates of the inmates received high appreciation from the managements of the homes who extended support to the volunteers.

There was a huge response from pensioners retired from many Departments of Govt of India, including Defence, Railways, BSNL, EPF, Autonomous Bodies, Banks and State Governments who attended in large numbers in the DLC camps organised by the associations. In the 30 camps held from 1st to 17th of November 2023, a record number of 2129 pensioners and family pensioners attended the camps. The volunteers generated their digital life certificates by making use of the fast and hassle free "Face Authentication Technology" launched by the Govt of India, Department of Pension and Pensioners Welfare in collaboration with The Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) & Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MietY). Camps in Sahakaranagar, Bengaluru attracted the maximum number of pensioners ie. 417 followed by Camps in Vidyananyapura , Bengaluru 372, Mysuru 189 and DRDO camp 178.

As on 25-11-2023 the total no. of Digital Life Certificates generated is a record 3299.

The 2 Associations' endeavour in helping pensioners of all hues to submit their annual life certificate **FREE OF CHARGES** will continue till 30th November 2023 and thereafter if requested.

Apart from generating life certificates of hundreds of pensioners in the camps, the volunteers trained a few interested pensioners in downloading the 2 Apps viz. Jeevan Pramaan and Aadhar Face Read app on their mobile phones needed for generating Digital Life Certificates. SOP for DLC registration was also made available to such willing pensioners. We are glad to record that some pensioners in Shivamogga, Chikkamagaluru and Mysuru have, in right earnest, started helping pensioners to submit their life certificates from the confines of their homes.
